# Oral Health Promotion Cards for Medical Settings

It is with great excitement that the State Oral Health Program publishes the Oral Health Promotion Cards for Medical Settings.

Dental caries is the most common chronic disease in the planet, and yet it is largely preventable. Research shows that poor oral health can impact other systemic diseases, such as diabetes, heart disease, and respiratory disease. For this reason, health care professionals have become more aware of their important role in promoting oral health, and consequently general health, among children and adults. It was in response to several requests for basic talking points about oral health that these materials were developed.

The Oral Health Promotion cards are designed for use in a variety of medical settings for women and children. They may be used by a variety of health professionals. Soon, cards with messages for adults and seniors will also be available.

# **Medical Investigator Fraud Alert**

The Medical Board of California recently alerted the Nursing Care Quality Assurance Commission about an individual fraudulently representing himself as a health care investigator in the Los Angeles area. The individual fraudulently identified himself as an investigator with the Medical Board of California when he contacts physicians requesting social security numbers and credit card numbers. He threatened cancellation of the physicians' licenses to practice if they are non-compliant with his requests. This individual is **not** associated with the Medical Board of California.

A similar scheme or the same individual could travel north along the I-5 corridor to Washington State and attempt to commit the same scam. If anyone contacts you as a Nursing Commission Investigator or Medical Commission Investigator requesting social security information or credit card information, please report the contact to your local law enforcement agency immediately, and to the Nursing Commission as soon as possible at 360.236.4700, or e-mail nursing@doh.wa.gov

# Applications now available for FQHC Medical Home Demo

The Innovation Center is pleased to announce that it is currently accepting applications from Federally Qualified Health Centers to participate in the Medicare Federally Qualified Health Center (FQHC) Advanced Primary Care Practice demonstration project. This demonstration is being conducted by Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMS) in partnership with the Health Resources and Services Administration (HRSA).

This 3-year demonstration project will test the effectiveness of doctors and other health professionals working in teams to coordinate and improve care for up to 195,000 Medicare patients. It will show how the patient-centered medical home model can improve quality of care, promote better health, and lower costs.

Two years of professional experience as a registered nurse after licensure are required before nurses can apply to volunteer with Mercy Ships. ## **AANA Strongly Supports IOM Pain Initiative**

The American Association of Nurse Anesthetists (AANA) applauds the Institute of Medicine (IOM) for their recent announcement of major new study results identifying pain as a serious public health problem, and expresses its appreciation and support for the IOM's initiative to improve pain care, education, and research. The 42,000 member AANA is a supporting organization of the Pain Care Act which authorized the undertaking of the landmark study.

Commissioned by the U.S. Congress, the study draws attention to the human and economic costs of pain, an epidemic that affects one in every four Americans. Ensuring patient access to safe, cost-effective anesthesia care and pain management has long been the mission of the AANA, whose members are advanced practice registered nurses specializing in these areas. Along with various other consumer, health professional, and advocacy organizations that deal with this issue, the AANA strongly supports the IOM in its efforts to study pain in greater depth and explore approaches to advance the field of pain care.

"The AANA is extremely grateful to Congress for recognizing the need for this study and to the IOM for achieving such impressive results," said Christine Zambricki, CRNA, MS, FAAN, deputy executive director of the AANA. "The work done so far, and the work that lies ahead, has the potential to revolutionize the treatment of pain and offer relief for the millions of Americans who live with pain day in and day out. As an organization representing anesthesia specialists, many of our members practice in pain management settings so the AANA's support of this research is a natural association."

The ultimate goal of the IOM study is to lessen the toll in human suffering caused by pain, while identifying economical alternatives that reduce healthcare and lostopportunity costs.

"CRNAs see firsthand the grave effects chronic pain has on patients. We anticipate that the study, along with the involvement of the IOM and leading healthcare and patient advocacy organizations that have already signed on to support this initiative, will encourage other organizations to join the cause of advancing pain management," said Zambricki.
